## Pick Up / Drop Off

When: the week of June 15th

Where: the flagpole OR the gym

## **Trimester 3 / End of Year Grading Recommendations**

The Grading Committee's goal was to develop guidelines to best address the realities of remote teaching and learning, respect the varying levels of support students received, and value students' work and participation. The committee recognized that traditional grading would be unable to adequately capture student growth and achievement in the final trimester of the 2019-2020 school year.

Report

Both primary and upper grades, as well as special areas, were represented on the committee.

## **Performance Levels/ Grading**



### All Grades:

- Performance Levels document **student growth or progress** towards grade level end-of-year standards (ES, MS, AS, PS, NS, X)
- Unless substantial evidence is available, Trimester 2 performance level indicators will be utilized to document Trimester 3 work; no student will drop levels.

### Grades 4-6

- There will be no Letter Grades for Special Areas
- Trimester 3 Grades will be a combination of: 60% completion and 40% accuracy
  - Completion = every week or particular assignment for completion of activities
  - Accuracy = regular grading
- Trimester 3 will be averaged with Trimesters 1 and 2 for Final Grade
