3232. TUTORING SERVICES

A. Additional Help in Academic Programs

- 1. Teachers will make every reasonable effort to assist pupils assigned to them who need additional help in their academic programs.
- 2. Additional help may be given during the course of the staff member's work day or before or after school hours.
- 3. This additional help is an extension of the staff member's assigned school district responsibilities and no staff member may charge a fee for providing this additional help to pupils.
- B. Private Tutoring Services
 - 1. A staff member who believes a pupil may benefit from private tutoring services in addition to any additional help provided to a pupil as part of the staff member's assigned responsibilities will inform the Principal or designee.
 - 2. If the Principal or designee concurs with the staff member's recommendation, he/she or the staff member will notify the pupil's parent/guardian. The Principal or designee will not recommend a private tutor or maintain a list of private tutors. The retention of a private tutor shall be the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian.
 - 3. The responsibility of contracting a private tutor is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. The Principal, staff member or designee will discuss the pupil's performance and needs with the pupil's parent/guardian.
 - 4. The school staff member shall cooperate with the pupil in providing information and materials used in class and in specifying the areas where the pupil needs tutoring.
 - 5. Private tutoring shall not take place on school grounds. Any fees or compensation arrangements shall be made between the private tutor and the parent/guardian. The Board of Education assumes no liability, or obligations for the selection of a private tutor that is contracted by the parent/guardian or the quality of the tutoring services provided.

6. A school staff member may be contracted by a parent/guardian to provide tutoring services to a pupil. School staff members are prohibited from providing private tutoring services to pupils currently enrolled in their classes or to a pupil who the staff member participates as a member of the pupil's evaluation team.
