Definitions



Goals are the desired outcomes necessary to fulfill the mission. They are positive, aspirational, and student-centered.



Objectives are the various means to accomplish goals. They are specific, tactical, and descriptive.



HOW – Specific tasks essential to carrying out the objectives. Written by administration.



Components of Goal Statement

TO

Action verb

 Increase, develop, obtain, complete, etc. To create

WHAT

- Statement of nouns
 - What you will impact

a safe and secure learning environment

SO THAT

What the outcome will do for you

GOAL WRITING PROCESS

Sample Goal Area:

Facilities and Finance/Safety and Security

Visions (from Meeting 2)

- •Interactive learning space open floor plans
- •Expand school choice program
- Virtual classrooms
- Safe learning environment
- •Equitable distribution of funds for facilities
- State-of-the-art facilities
- •All "green" facilities

Strengths (from Meeting 1)

- Safety and security
- Facilities improvements
- Building configurations
- •Class size space

Challenges

- Environmental concerns
- Older buildings
- Safety and security
- Mandates and resources drain



GOAL WRITING PROCESS

Sample Goal Statement

Goal Area: Facilities and Finance/Safety and

Security

Goal Statement: Create a safe and secure learning environment equipped to deliver 21st century programs.

Objectives:

- •Upgrade facilities to be more energy and cost efficient
- Increase internal and external security at all schools
- •Upgrade existing facilities to be more structurally modernized.
