Smocks:

PreK and Kindergarten: Please look for instructions from your child's teacher, as they use smocks in their classroom and bring them to art room on art days.

1st, 2nd, 3rd: Please bring a smock during the first week or two of school. An oversized t-shirt works well. Please have your child's name labeled on the smock and in a ziplock bag also labeled with their name and class code. The bag should be large enough for your child to remove and replace the smock easily by themselves.

4th, 5th, 6th: Smocks are optional, and can be brought in according to above instructions.

It is also helpful to make a note of what day we meet for art class, and to **"dress for mess."** Please don't wear your newest, best, and favorite outfits on art day.
