Several times throughout the year the Roseland Recreation Department applies a treatment application to our front and rear baseball infields and the Roseland Board of Education applies a treatment application to our outdoor classroom/courtyard. There are four applications that occur between April 2019 – Fall 2019 after school hours, usually on holiday weekends.

It is required that everyone remain off the applied area at least 8 hours after the application. We ask that you remain off the infields for the days stated above.
