

Hurricane Fundraiser

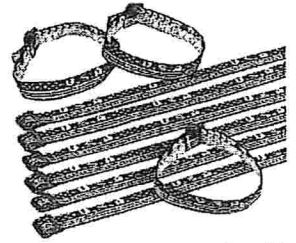
Red Cross employees have been working around the clock to help in the relief efforts for Hurricane Irma and Hurricane Harvey.
