It is required that everyone remain off the applied area at least 72 hours after the application. We ask that you remain off the infields for the **November 23, 2017 (after school/early dismissal day) - November 25, 2017**.

This is a routine application which is part of scheduled applications that occur throughout the year. Thank you in advance for your cooperation in observing these restrictions.
