Program for 4-Year-Olds and Entering Kindergartners

In this fun summer program, we teach children to read. They learn letter recognition, beginning phonics, and easy sight words. Children learn to read simple words and short sentences and are excited about books and reading.

**Program for Entering 1st Graders**
