- 4. Evaluates each student's progress in meeting the course standards in comprehension, speaking, reading, and/or writing world languages.
- 5. Evaluates academic and social growth of students.
- 6. Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior needed to provide an orderly, productive classroom environment.
- 7. Identified student needs and cooperates with other professional staff members in assessing and helping students solve learning, health, and attitude problems.

- 8. Communicates with parents and school counselors on student progress.
- 9. Supervises students in assigned out-of-classroom activities during the assigned working day.
- 10. Participates in faculty committees and the sponsorship of student activities.
- 11. Models nondiscriminatory practices in all activities.
- 12. Performs other duties within the scope of his/her employment and certification as may be assigned.
