Using Google Drive

- All students and teachers use Google Drive to store their work.
- Documents can be shared between students and teachers.
- Students can access their Google Drive anywhere and group projects can be worked on virtually

Projects Using Chromebooks

- Wrote D.A.R.E. essays and shared with teacher
- Created a character chart for the novel they are reading. Differentiated groups of students were assigned different characters in the chart to analyze. Students input character traits/actions/behaviors and quotes/evidence supporting these characteristics. • When completed each student has an analysis of the characters in preparation for the novel assessment and writing assignment.

Chromebook Use in RWW Class

Students can view online research (such as a video or article) to include in an essay as textual support. Students appreciate the ability to easily switch between their documents and the Internet.


 Chromebook use in RWW class
Documents are saved and shared automatically and changes are made instantaneously. There is no lost time in redoing documents.
